## 3: Crochet Stitch Reference - the Basics

Stitch (Abbreviation)	Chain (ch)	Slip Stitch (ss)	Single Crochet (sc)	Half Double (hdc)	Double (dc)	Triple (tr)	Double Triple (ttr)
Symbol	○	●	+	┆	┆	┆	┆
<b>Stage 1:</b> Yoh	No	No	No	Yes: x 1	Yes: x 1	Yes: x 2	Yes: x 3
<b>Stage 2:</b> Insert hook	No	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes
<b>Stage 3:</b> Yoh, draw through fabric only	No - yoh, draw through loop on hook	No - yoh, draw through fabric and loop on hook	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes
<b>Stage 4:</b> Yoh, draw through 2 loops this number of times	No (finished!)	No (finished!)	1	No - yoh, draw through all 3 loops	2	3	4
<b>Base Chain:</b> Number of extra chains to make (more than the number of stitches in the row!)	-	1	1	1 (2)	2	3	4
<b>Base Row:</b> Number of chains to miss at beginning of Row 1	-	1	2 (1)	2 (2)	3 (2)	4 (3)	5 (4)
<b>Turning Chain (tch):</b> Number of chains to make at beginning of Row 2 onwards	-	0 or 1	1 or 2 (1)	2 (2)	3 (2)	4 (3)	5 (4)
<b>In-the-Round:</b> Base Chain Ring:	-	-	3	3	4	4	5
Number of stitches in Round 1 and also number of increases per round from Round 2 onwards	-	-	6	8	12	18	24

Use the alternative figures in brackets when the turning chain does not count as a stitch
